Adolescent Treatment & Recovery Program

Sensitive to the special needs of adolescents, Tempo Group's Adolescent program is specifically designed for the teenager who is experiencing difficulty managing their life due to substance use. Prevention and Parenting Programs

Our Prevention program provides parents and teens an opportunity to come together to resolve what could be one of the greatest concerns facing the family: Teen Drug and Alcohol Use. This program is specially geared towards at-risk youths and their families. It is designed to provide an arena for shared learning and discussion around personal values and concerns relating to substance use and teens. We offer multifamily group, individual and family prevention services. Additionally, the Margaret Basner Parenting Center, is a wellness center for parents with children of all ages.

The Parenting Center is an educational resource center. Workshops include practical techniques and workable strategies for the everyday situations that arise for parents in today's stressful and rapidly changing world. Parent educational programs are also brought directly to the community.

Youth Services Center

A social and recreational program for youth-at-risk. The Youth Center has been deemed a "Center for Alternatives". These students participate in programs including community service projects. The Center plays an important role in developing positive peer relationships and building a youngster's sense of self-esteem and worth.

Family Education and Treatment Program

Parents, children, spouses and other loved ones are educated about the nature of chemical dependency. An initial educational series, about the disease, begins to give family members an understanding of the illness and serves as a compassionate arena in which to voice their feelings. The group process offers family members and loved ones access to professional counseling. We offer specialty groups for parents, spouses, children of substance abusers (COSA) as well as siblings of substance abusers. COSA and sibling treatment specifically works with children to identify and express their feelings, and to build social and coping skills to prevent the repetitive family cycle of addiction.
